Ticket Talk . . . Mae Rosenkranz



Opening Day [April 13th vs. Arizona] is right around the corner and we are starting to gear up for it. It's going to be another exciting year. And if you don't already know it, the Yankees are coming to town June 25th-27th. There are new guidelines for purchasing tickets for the Yankee series, so please read and abide accordingly.

In order to qualify to order tickets for the Yankee games (Fri June 25th & Sun June 27th) you must first be a member in good standing, and then you must order and pay for a minimum of 4 games prior to the Yankee games. If there are more orders for tickets than the club is actually going to receive, we will be following the guidelines of the By-Laws, which means you must have attended 5 meetings in 2009 in order to qualify, and then the tickets will be allocated according to the number of LADBC scheduled group games attended by a member.

Tickets shall initially be limited to one ticket per member per game. Exceptions to this allocation may be made on a case-by-case basis by the Board of Directors. For those of you that have not attended the requisite number of meetings do not lose heart. In the event that not all tickets are claimed by qualifying members, any remaining tickets may be allocated by the board to fill the requests of any remaining members.

For those who live outside of Southern California and want to attend, **please contact me ASAP, at 000.000.0000**, or email 000000@000.com. Ticket Prices for the Yankee series are \$35.00 for both regular seats and handicap. FYI - the club is also being allocated by the Dodgers, thus your allocation.

Enclosed is the Projection Sheet for 2010 - please fill out completely, providing ALL information requested. Select the games you want to attend with the number of tickets you want for each game, and return the top WHITE copy to me by the February 8th meeting, and keep the yellow copy for your records. Tickets are to be paid for or canceled no later than 15 days prior to game date, except Opening Day which must be paid for by the March 8th meeting. Here again, the Dodgers are requesting full payment prior to me picking up the Opening Day tickets. You may enclose a check for all the tickets you ordered, or for any portion of them now, or you may pay for them by home stand when the tickets become available. Always read my Ticket Talk article in the monthly Booster Bits, as I always announce the home stand(s) and tickets that will be available and ready for pick up at the next meeting.
