## Booster Blog . . . Brent Wood

Before Kenley Jansen, Eric Gagne, Tom Niedenfuer, Mike Marshall (the pitcher), Jim Brewer, Phil Regan or even Ron Perranoski, there was **Larry Sherry**. Larry Sherry was a Los Angeles native who was the star relief pitcher for the Dodgers during the 1959 World Championship year.

In the 1959 World Series against the Chicago White Sox, Sherry pitched 12.2 innings in relief, appearing in four of the six games, saving two of them with an ERA of 0.71. Arguably, his greatest regular season game was on August 15 1959, when he pitched 8 2/3 innings in relief and drove in three

runs in a 4-3 victory over the St. Louis Cardinals. Sherry would pitch for the Dodgers through the 1963 season. On April 9, 1964, he was traded to the Detroit Tigers for Lou Johnson. Larry Sherry continued to pitch until he retired after the 1968 season with the Angels. Larry Sherry passed away on December 17, 2006 at the age of 71. **During the 1959 season, no one was better at relief than Larry Sherry.**
