
Membership Notes . . . Danee Gallegos & Brenda Marsh

Booster Blog . . . Brent Wood

On July 20, we will celebrate the 50th anniversary of Apollo 11's landing on the moon. This was no small task and it fulfilled President Kennedy's goal of having a man on the moon by the end of the 1960's. This is an accomplishment that should provide a national pride, even 50 years later. On a much simpler scale, the Dodgers had their own version of a "Moon Shot" with an outfielder who found a home in LA during the 1959 season, Wally Moon. Wally Moon was originally signed by the St. Louis Cardinals and was traded to the Dodgers in December of 1958 for Gino Cimoli. He was a left-handed hitter who played the outfield. In 1959, his first season with the Dodgers, the team played in the LA Coliseum. The fence to left field was 251 feet down the line with a 40-foot-high fence. Stan Musial advised Moon to alter his swing thus taking advantage of the shorter distance. The result was Wally Moon hit 19 homeruns, 74 RBIs, with a .302 batting average and he led the majors in triples with 11. His homeruns became known as Moon shots for they would loft over the left field fence. Wally Moon finally retired in 1965. Ironically, that was the first year of the Gemini program, which sent two astronauts into space, thus opening the door for the real "moon shot" in July of 1969.

DIRECTIONS: LoanMart Field is located at 8408 Rochester Avenue in Rancho Cucamonga, conveniently located near the intersection of the 10 & 15 freeways, and is easily accessible from all major highways. From Los Angeles / Orange County and all points west – take the 10, 60 or 91 Freeway east to the 15 Freeway north. Exit at Foothill Blvd, turn left off the exit and after 1/4 mile, turn left onto Rochester Avenue. From San Bernardino / Riverside / Redlands and all points east and south, take the 10, 60 or 91 Freeway west to the 15 Freeway north. Exit at Foothill Blvd, turn left off the exit and after 1/4 mile, turn left onto Rochester Avenue. From the 210 Freeway, either east or west – exit at Milliken Avenue and head south. Turn left on Foothill Blvd and after 1/2 mile, turn right onto Rochester Avenue.
